

Subject: **Agenda Item 11: Discussion and possible action regarding impact of California Performance Review upon the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.**

Staff Recommendation: That the Conservancy discuss the California Performance Review report recommendations as they affect the Conservancy and offer direction for comment or other action.

Legislative Authority: Section 33211(c) of the Public Resources Code.

Background: The California Performance Review report was released earlier this month. The attached spreadsheet prepared by staff outlines only a few of the issues that may impact the Conservancy. The Resources Agency requested departments to submit staff comments on “operational issues” by mid-August; with structural change recommendations to be commented upon later. The California Performance Review Commission is holding a short series of public hearings on their report. The meeting of September 13 is to be held in Fresno for testimony on the report’s environmental and resources recommendations.
